Dear Denver Century Ride Community:

It has been a few weeks since we last communicated with you regarding the impact of COVID-19 on our planning and contingencies for the 2020 ride, presently scheduled for Saturday, June 20, 2020. We wanted to keep you apprised of our current status.

As you know, Gov. Polis has extended the stay at home order until Sunday, April 26th. Based upon the state's announcements regarding the "reopening" of society at that time, we will make a decision in the following few days of our intention to proceed with our original date or move to our previously announced back-up date on Saturday, August 22nd.

As you can imagine a variety of factors will go into that decision in addition to government and CDC guidelines for operating a safe and enjoyable ride. We will weigh them all, along with the impact on our municipalities, public safety providers, sponsors, volunteers and especially you, our cyclists.

In any event, we will commit to announce any changes by the first week of May to provide you with a full six weeks advance notice for your planning and preparation.
